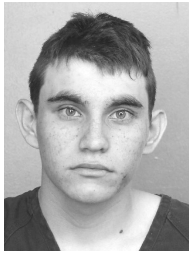

A memorial to the victims of mass school shootings in the USA



2017: WILLIAM ATCHISON.

The Aztec High School shooting was a school shooting and murder-suicide by 21-year-old former student William Atchison on December 7, 2017, in Aztec, New Mexico, United States. Atchison entered the school in the morning disguised as a current student and hid in the school restroom. He was discovered before he could launch a major attack, but shot and killed two students before killing himself.



2018: NIKOLAS CRUZ

On February 14, 2018, 19-year-old Nikolas Cruz opened fire on students and staff at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in the Miami suburban town of Parkland, Florida, United States, murdering 17 people and injuring 17 others. Cruz, a former student at the school, fled the scene on foot by blending in with other students and was arrested without incident approximately one hour later.



2021: ETHAN CRUMBLEY

On November 30, 2021, a mass shooting occurred at Oxford High School in the Detroit suburb of Oxford Township, Michigan, United States. 15-year old Ethan Crumbley, armed with a 9 mm semi-automatic handgun, murdered four students and injured seven people, including a teacher.



2022: SALVADOR RAMOS

On May 24, 2022, a mass shooting occurred at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas, United States, where 18-year-old Salvador Ramos, a former student at the school, fatally shot 19 students and two teachers, while 17 others were injured but survived. After shooting and severely wounding his grandmother at their home earlier that day
